Although this is not an event formally linked to Dental Vocational Training, the choice of name above is appropriate.

Over the years, the London Dental VTs and Trainers and their friends, have helped fund projects in Musoma, Tanzania through the charity walks along River Thames. You can see how much difference this has made to Tanzania on the following websites.

Some of these dentists have continued to support these events through this dinner. In the last two years, this fun filled event and a reunion of old friends raised some £15,000 to fund these projects. Proceeds are donated towards projects in Musoma. Musoma (Administrative HQ of Mara Region) is situated on the eastern shores of Lake Victoria. Famous Serengeti National Park is part of the Mara Region. You can easily visit this from Musoma as a day trip. Whilst Mara Region is very beautiful and resourceful, for

various reasons, even by Tanzanian standards people remain poor. There is a 13 % disability rate in the Mara Region.

Lake Victoria Disability Centre (LVDC) is a 7.5 acre complex part funded by the AOG and dentists. During the last four years we have completed over a dozen buildings. These include residential accommodations for orphans/disabled, schools, adult training workshops, Medical and Dental Clinics, Library, Computer Workshops and much more. Volunteers can help with anything at all including teaching Sport, Music, English, Carpentry, Metal Work, Sewing, Computers, DIY, Physiotherapy, Dentistry or Medicine. Or simply talk to people!
